# Easy Pump Network Info



Terminal IDs must be added by the network for each fueling point/terminal being upgraded, prior to placing an order.

## 1. The site owner/manager must request the additional terminal ID(s) from their network merchant/ISO.

- Example: (3) Dispensers will have (6) fueling points.  
(6) Terminal IDs will need to be added to the site profile.

• How many fueling points are you upgrading? \_\_\_\_\_  
This is the number of additional Terminal IDs needed.

- First Data sites use Authorization ID Type **RB** – Rapid Connect - Self Registration.

## 2. Request a VAR/Parameter Sheet from the network merchant/ISO.

- Email the VAR/Parameter sheet to your Freedom sales representative. It should include the following information for First Data or Heartland, depending on your network:

# Easy Pump Prerequisites



## Gilbarco

- Dispensers will require printer replacement for proper operation.
- Dispensers with 10.4" displays CANNOT be upgraded at this time.
- Non-CRIND 300/500 and 500S/700S dispensers CANNOT be upgraded.
- Non-CRIND and CRIND Advantage dispensers CAN be upgraded.

## Wayne

- Dispensers with DW-12, DW-10, and Clamshell printers can be upgraded with the standard kit.
- Dispensers with Tearbar printers will require the FE-Tear Bar Kit for proper printer operation. (sold separately)
- DCPT Robust printers are NOT compatible with Easy Pump.
- Dispensers with 10.4" displays will require 5.7" panels to upgrade.  
Part# 887818-002-XXX – colors vary.
- Non-CAT Ovation and Vista dispensers CANNOT be upgraded.

## Wayne Vista Keypad Specifications

- Vista kits are ONLY available to upgrade from TRSM keypads. These keys have a flat surface.



- Vista kits are NOT available to upgrade from SPM keypads. These keys will protrude.



## Verifone

- The Verifone Commander/RubyCi must be minimum Base 51.
- Only First Data and Heartland, Unbranded and Sinclair locations are certified at this time.
- A Cybera Enhanced Zone Router or MNSP is required.
- If using a Cybera EZR, it must still be commissioned by Cybera and able to obtain a VPN.

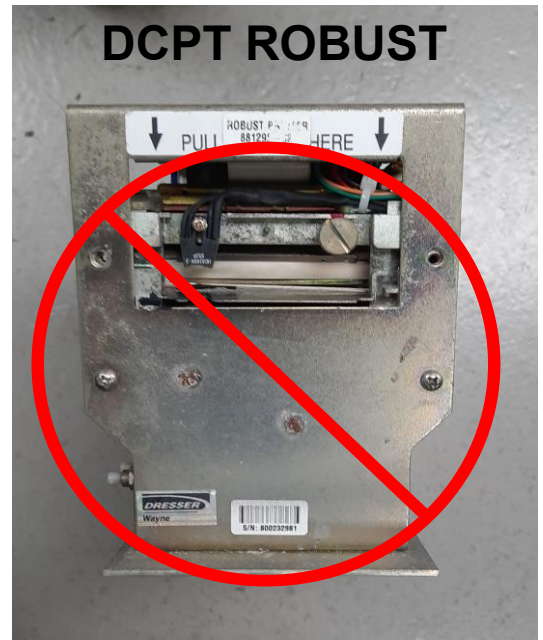
# Wayne Printer Specifications
